Read the word problem. Count and write the answer.

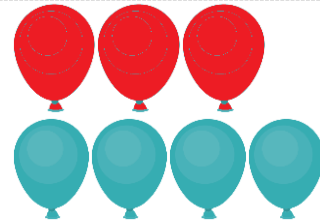
There are 6 boys and 4 girls in the class. How many total kids are there?

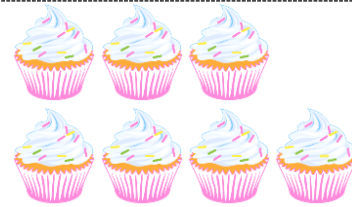
Sam has 3 red balloons and 4 blue balloons. How many balloons does he have?
